ACWA Power acquired a controlling stake in Jordan's Central Electricity Generation Company (CEGCO) in 2011. CEGCO is one of the largest power generator in Jordan with several power generation sites across the country totalling nearly 1,044 MW of installed power capacity from a mixed portfolio by technology and fuel type meeting about 24% of the country's electricity needs.

Jordan's electricity demand will continue to grow apace in the next decade. The acquisition of CEGCO represented an opportunity for ACWA Power to supply electricity reliably and at the lowest possible cost in the Kingdom.
